Host Requirements

Essential:

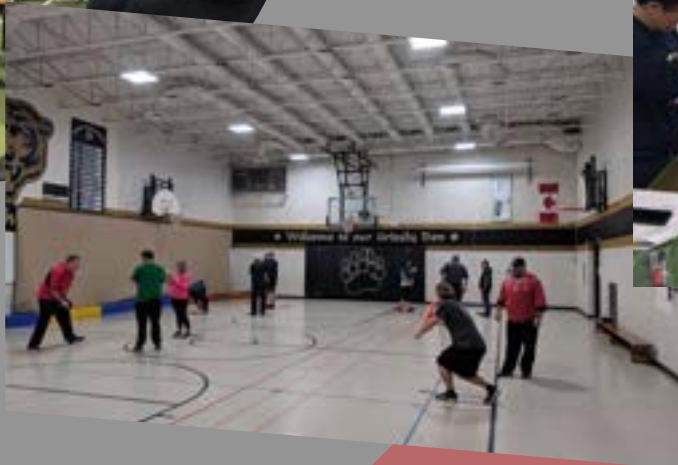
