Slo-Pitch Clinic Instructor JOB DESCRIPTION

Major Objective/Purpose

a. To instruct at Softball Ontario Slo-Pitch umpire clinics as assigned

Qualifications

- a. Must be a minimum Level III Certified in Slo-Pitch
- b. Should have completed a certified clinic at least one level above the one they are teaching in Slo-Pitch
- c. Demonstrate above average teaching ability
- c. Have excellent knowledge of content and program in Slo-Pitch
- d. Have the ability to analyze and correct basic mechanics and skills of the game of softball
- e. Have the ability to evaluate and constructively criticize future instructors
- f. Have the ability to teach adults effectively in an enjoyable atmosphere
- g. The individual must be an registered and carded umpire with Softball Ontario
- h. The individual must be an active Slo-Pitch umpire registered with Softball Ontario by April 15 of each year. If not registered by April 15 of the current year, the SP PUIC has the right to remove the volunteer from his/her duties.
- i. Must complete a Softball Ontario Volunteer Application.
- j. Must sign Association's Confidentiality Agreement prior to March 31st and/or prior to assumption of duties. Refusing to sign agreement they will not be permitted to be a volunteer for Softball Ontario's SP Umpire Program.
- k. Have attended a Softball Canada Instructor/Evaluator Clinic an asset.

Responsibilities

- a. Must be available as an instructor Slo-Pitch clinics as required
- b. Ensure all clinic registration forms, clinic evaluation forms, expenses claim forms, etc. are filled out completely and returned to the Softball Ontario office immediately following the clinic
- c. Assist in the improvement and updating of the present programs
- d. Continually update and expand knowledge of Softball Ontario and all its programs
- e. To carry out their duties consistent with the expectation and practices of the umpires' program
- f. <u>To set an exemplary model at all times</u>. This example includes:
 - Dress and deportment
 - <u>Manner</u>
 - Rapport with all public being served

Commitment/Duration of the Job

a. The position of SP Instructor covers a one-year period.

Supervisor

a. The Slo-Pitch Instructor reports directly to the Slo-Pitch Deputy Provincial Umpire-in-Chief Responsible for coordinating the Slo-Pitch clinics

Orientation/Training

a. Instructor must attend the provincial or zone Instructor Training Meeting prior to the softball season.
